Works Alone or With Sprinklers.

The Protector functions as a complete, standalone system where full sprinkler networks are impractical — or as a powerful complement to smoke alarms and sprinklers.

Unlike sprinklers, which only trigger once extreme heat shatters the bulb, The Protector detects danger earlier, controlling the fire in its first moments and buying precious time for evacuation and response.

While sprinklers are essential in some facilities, they only activate when fire heat reaches a level high enough to break the bulb, by which time damage can be severe. The Protector steps in sooner, controlling the fire in its earliest stages and providing precious time for evacuation and emergency response.

Stops Fires at the Source

Advanced sensors quickly identify real hazards while ignoring harmless flames like candles. Once confirmed, The Protector releases a water-based retardant that halts flames before they spread, reducing damage and disruption.

Traditional sprinklers flood entire rooms. The Protector delivers precise, targeted suppression, avoiding unnecessary water damage and costly clean-ups.

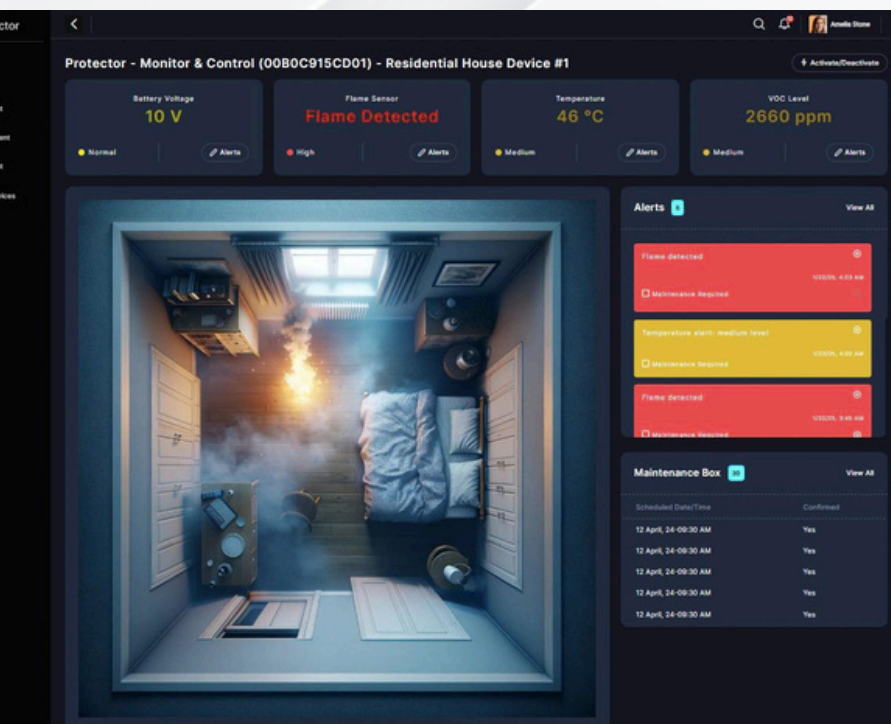
